

Copy and Records Request Policy

Copies & Faxes

Copies of public records or to copy personal items will have a fee. A charge of \$.25 each sheet will be billed and must be paid prior to the release of requested copies. (NDCC 44-04-18.2)

Faxes will be charged \$1.00 for the first five sheets and an additional \$0.25 for each sheet after that.

(Notices now published stating "copy for review" will need to be more specific. When stating copies available for review, it should include must remain at City Hall or if requesting a copy, charges will apply—example Budget notice)

Electronic Records

Electronic records are free if recoverable without the use of a computer backup. If a request is made for records on a backup or of the backup, the costs for retrieving this information will be billed to the requester. (NDCC 44-04-18.3)

Research

A fee of \$25.00 per hour excluding the first initial hour will be charged for any request requiring research for fulfilling request and/or removing confidential or closed information on such records. (NDCC 44-04-18.2)

Outside Agent Help

If an outside agency or entity is required or requested to fulfill a records request, any fees billed to the City for such request will be billed to the requester or the requester shall pay the fee to that agency or entity directly. (NDCC 44-04-18.2)

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:

Household Garbage
Chemical cans, barrels or hazardous waste
Tires
Electronics (TV/PC/Printers etc)

ITEMS ACCEPTED:

Building Material
Mattresses
Furniture
Appliances (tagged)
Trees, branches, wood

**Trees & Branches MUST be less than 6 feet in length, 12 inches in diameter
and have no roots to be disposed of free of charge**

Tree branches need to be placed in burn pile
Recyclable metals need to be placed in separate container
Concrete needs to be placed in a separate pile
Shingles need to be placed in a separate container

All loads must be separated before entering site to avoid possible turning away of your load

COMPOST

Open Daily during daylight hours

Compost Pile is located by the waste disposal site and is free of charge

Only Grass clippings, leaves, garden waste and wood chips are allowed at this site

NO TWIGS, BRANCHES, TREES OR WOOD SCRAPS.

**From Oakes: The Disposal Site/Compost Pile is located 2 miles west on County Rd 3 –
then ¾ of a mile south on 108th Ave**
