

The City of Oakes is implementing changes to the garbage collection method in an effort to save money and streamline the process. The City will now be collecting and hauling trash directly to the landfill in Gwinner. With the added time for hauling, some changes are being made to speed up the route. All totes will now be placed on one side of the road so the truck will only make one pass on each street/avenue. The enclosed map is color coded to help illustrate where your tote will need to be placed. **Your collection day will not change.** These changes will take effect the week of **August 20th**. ORANGE STREETS/AVENUES – YOU MAY CONTINUE TO PLACE YOUR TOTE IN THE SAME LOCATION YOU CURRENTLY DO
(Aspen Dr, Burlwood Dr, Chestnut Ln, Glenwood Dr, Evergreen Ave, Industrial Park, N 13th St Cul-de-sac, Main Ave, & Hwy 1 - 7th St)

PINK STREETS – YOU WILL BE NEED TO PLACE YOUR TOTE ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE STREET
(2nd St, 4th St, 6th St, 8th St, 10th St, 12th St, 14th St)

GREEN STREETS – YOU WILL NEED TO PLACE YOUR TOTE ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE STREET
(1st St, 3rd St, 5th St, 9th St, 11th St, 13th St, 15th St)

PURPLE AVENUES – YOU WILL NEED TO PLACE YOUR TOTE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE STREET
(Elm Ave, Fir Ave, Hickory Ave, Ivy Ave, Kola Ave, Maple Ave, Quince Ave, Scotch Ave)

YELLOW AVENUES – YOU WILL NEED TO PLACE YOUR TOTE ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE STREET
(Dogwood Ave, Grape Ave, Juniper Ave, Lilac Ave, Nectarine Ave, Pine Ave)
