- Do not block or place obstacles in front of recycling container

TIPS AND REMINDERS BEST PRACTICES FOR RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS

Tips.

Safety for your property & Waste Management driver:

- Maintain clear and safe access to your waste and/or recycling containers
- Make sure your containers are visible to the driver from the road
- > Keep your cart and bin at least 3 feet from any stationary objects
- ➤ In the winter, please salt and sand approaches to your container and do not place your containers on top of a snow bank
- > Keep container clear of snow and ice

Avoiding delay of service:

- ➤ Have your garbage and recyclables placed out to the road NO LATER THAN 5:00 AM on your scheduled day of service or night before, *please check local ordinances*
- > Drivers may service your area at a different time each week
- > Avoid placing your items out based on previous pickup times of the day
- > If you feel that you have been missed, please call Customer Service immediately

Keeping a clean area:

- > If you have additional volume of waste, please place these bags on the side of your cart
- Additional bags outside of your cart will be an additional charge, please call Customer Service for more information.
- > Containers should never be overloaded, please keep them at a level limit
- > Bulky waste services are offered in limited areas, please call Customer Service for more information

Disposing of waste properly:

- > Bag your waste to avoid spillage when dumping
- > Keep the lids on your containers closed
- > Avoid placing the containers underneath an overhang as the water runoff can freeze items into the container
- > Please be sure to place only approved items into containers
- > A contaminated container can contaminate a whole truck load!

The following items are NOT allowed in general waste containers.
